BOSTON ELEVATED.

New Elevated Extension to Cost \$4,300,000, and Subway Extension \$6,350,300, is Estimate.

Boston—The Boston Elevated has filed with the railroad commission its preliminary estimate of cost of constructing the Cambridge Main Street subway and the East Cambridge extension.

The East Cambridge extension, an elevated from the north station to Lechmere Square, Cambridge, will cost \$4,300,000. The cost of the Cambridge Main Street subway, from Beacon Hill tunnel to Harvard Square is \$6,350,300.
