

### Harvard Square Business Association Minutes February 3, 2012

President John DiGiovanni called the meeting to order at 9:00 am with introductions.

The Minutes of the January board meeting were approved as written. John asked that the minutes be amended to indicate that the Board retired to executive session to discuss the Harvard Square Business Initiative, which was again re-affirmed as our guideline for business development.

Treasurer: Brian Kelley had a meeting in the bank and would be arriving late. Denise reported that some dues came in early so we were able to be "in the black" in January—a first! Bills have been sent out to our internet banner holders as well as to the parking garage owners. Brian's committee decided to hold our dues at the same level for 2012—this is the third year we have forgone an increase. Denise thinks we are in good shape fiscally and have the money to add the additional brackets to our new lampposts on which to hang 140 Victorian flower baskets (up from 115 last year).

#### **Committee Reports:**

Membership: Mary-Catherine had to be away unexpectedly. Denise was delighted to announce our two new members: Orinoco (a new restaurant featuring Venezuelan and Caribbean cuisine) and Planet Records (in the Square since 1983, now located near Darwin's on Mt. Auburn Street). The next membership committee meeting will be held at Citizens Bank; the committee greatly appreciates the years of generous hosting by Richard Carbone at The Inn at Harvard.

<u>Events and Media:</u> Bill Manley is enjoying the hard work **and** the good times (and the good winter weather?) this January. "January was incredibly fun and exciting! We celebrated Sheldon Cohen, gobbled green eggs and ham at the Go Green breakfast, and lined the street from the Brattle florist all the way to Palmer Street to sample chocolate (featured in a full by the Cambridge Chronicle)." The Boston Magazine highlighted 40 Winks, and cellist, YoYo Ma, plugged Passim. Coming up next month: "Some like it hot!"—our chili cook-off; our Chinese New Year celebration (Paul Lee will be dancing with the Dragon); and, of course, Valentine's Day. "It seems like something is going on every weekend!"

<u>Hospitality:</u> Benson Willis is looking forward to coordinating more events with the restaurant committee, so sign up to help! Benson's committee is starting a monthly mixer: cocktails and food at different venues in The Square. Wagamama will be the first, now that they have a full bar. "The mixers are for staff and the employees, too—a fun way to get together," noted Benson. The next committee meeting will be a Rialto on Valentines Day.

<u>Internet</u>: Matt ran us through the usual highlights—January was the best we've ever had and the number of visitors spiked at the end of January (a chocolate high?). New WiFi equipment (made by Meraki) will be installed this summer to improve reliability and performance. Tod and his committee will continue to work on the details of John Schall's coupon/Groupon idea: next meeting at Hammond Real Estate next Friday at 10am.

#### Other Business:

John Schall and Mary-Catherine will renew their efforts to convert Harvard Square vendors into corporate, dues-paying members.

Gino's B2B discount program is being worked on.

The Annual Meeting will be on March 2 at The Russell House Tavern From Terry Smith: The City Council gave the City Manager permission to refinance \$38M of Cambridge's debt—saving us several million dollars.

Meeting was adjourned at 10:00am with Councilor vanBeuzekom saying, "This was a lot more fun than a city council meeting!"


Traffic since May 2007 19.31% Annual Increase from 2011-2012
