President John DiGiovanni called the meeting to order at 9:04am with introductions.

The Minutes of the December board meeting were approved as written.

Treasurer: Brian Kelley quickly reviewed our end of the year results. The bottom line is we only ended in the red by \$3,000, which is excellent considering we had budgeted for a loss of \$90,000 for capital improvements (to cover website and Kiosk planning costs). Brian pointed out that our slight negative was due to Denise's skillful and astute fiscal management—income was down by \$78,000, offset by a matching total expense decrease of \$76,000. Bertil wondered why our income from sponsorships last year was unusually low (off by at least \$25,000); Denise had no specific clue—sponsorships are hard to predict. She doesn't think we've fallen out of favor.

Committee Reports:

Membership: Mary-Catherine was very pleased with our 7 new members (Beyond Success, The Poet's Corner, Chestnut Hill Realty, Quality Graphics, T. Edmund Garrity, Cooper Gallery, Tripda). Next meeting is 1/21/15. Total dues collected for 2014 was \$133,143 another new record!

Events and Media: Denise started off this report by dimming the lights and showing a short video clip of our Latke event created by Will Eifler. Not only will it be posted to harvardsquare.com but it is also something we can use to show potential sponsors how we can mobilize a crowd on their behalf. Bill stepped in to bring us up to date on our Winter Carnival which runs from January 9th through March 8th. The kickoff event is at Passim, which typically brings 1,000 visitors to the Square who will Celtic dance the night away. There are many other wonderful activities—14 pages, in fact, the two biggest are: the Chocolate Tasting (2,000-3,000 people last year)

and our **Some like it Hot Chili** Festival. Our Carnival ends at Chinese New Year, which happens to coincide with the 60th anniversary of the Hong Kong Restaurant. Denise and Bill delight in the fact that so many of our wonderful small and very successful events evolved from ideas suggested by board members. Kari brought us Think Pink and Latkes; John Schall, the Winter Carnival theme; Dan Hogan and Carolyn Goff, our Salsa event. If you have ideas try them out on Bill and Denise; who knows, you might inspire our next success!

<u>Hospitality:</u> Daniel Berger-Jones and his crew met at Night Market thanks to Jerry Tracy. Daniel and Dan are going to continue as a team for 2015 with the notion to make the Square more hospitable. The committee is interested to see about having our electrical boxes painted by artists. If you'd like to contribute to some civic-minded work, contact Daniel-- he needs 3-6 volunteers at the **Helping Hands** Event on Martin Luther King Day.

Nominating: Brian pinched-hit for Jerry Murphy. Jerry again is chairing our committee, joined by John DiGiovanni, Patrick Lee, Cindy Kuppens, Suzanna Krmzian and Denise. At their next meeting on January 15th they will review the nominations submitted by our members.

Internet: Tod's committee did review a new mobile app called Yillio modified exclusively for the HSBA so we can promote business to our walking consumers. Yillio allows retailers to easily offer discounts, sales or promotions with just a few clicks of their mobile device. We had a few edits for its creator and HSBA member, Vadim Droznin and hope to unveil it soon. The committee also began discussions on ways to monetize our mobile site—Bob Fitta suggested that we consider the revenue model that Harvard Magazine uses. Natalie took us through her WebStat report: we continue to add new Facebook, Twitter and Instagram followers. Natalie is also considering adding a Travel site as another point of comparison. Warm blankets for Cambridge Homeless was one of the most liked and shared pictures and it raised \$7,400 for Councilor McGovern's thoughtful initiative. Marc also posted our picture to his Facebook page—so we garnered goodwill with his constituents as well.

Other Business:

"Having a capable and prepared staff, along with unparalleled community partners in both the City of Cambridge and Harvard University, enables us to seize opportunities and run with them. We are known as a credible organization that gets things done!" John DiGiovanni.





Harvard Square Social Media Overview as of February 2015

















2011 - 2014


Each November, the Harvard Square Business Association announces its annual calendar of events for the upcoming year. We make the announcement early for several reasons; to give our members the opportunity to plan in advance, to budget accordingly and to purchase appropriate merchandise. Early announcements ensure that our events will get listed in travel and tourism guides which are printed well in advance of the new year. And finally, the calendar is created to inform folks who are planning to vacation in the area. On average, we anticipate producing over seventy events per year; many of which are annual events like MayFair and Oktoberfest.

In addition to our scheduled events, we, as well as the City of Cambridge, receive dozens of requests throughout the year from organizations, corporations and individuals who want to have a presence in Harvard Square. The requests are varying and can range from musical performances to sampling opportunities, from tasting events to social media activations. We work closely with the City to ensure the successful execution of these events that are categorized in the following ways:


- Supplemental: Events that take place under the umbrella of the HSBA. We did not initiate them, although we are actively involved in their planning, permitting, marketing, implementation and promotion.
- Multimedia: Events/promotions that take place inside our businesses and do not typically require permitting; however, we are actively involved in their planning, occasional permitting, marketing, implementation and promotion.
- Sponsored activations: Events that come our way via marketing companies. They often involve sampling or demonstrations. The HSBA is responsible for the planning, permitting, marketing, implementation and promotion of these activations.

The following pages detail all four categories of these events that took place over a four-year period, from 2011 through 2014. The events are listed by category and a variety are accompanied by colorful photos taken by Bill Manley who

captures the spirit and beauty of them through his lens.






